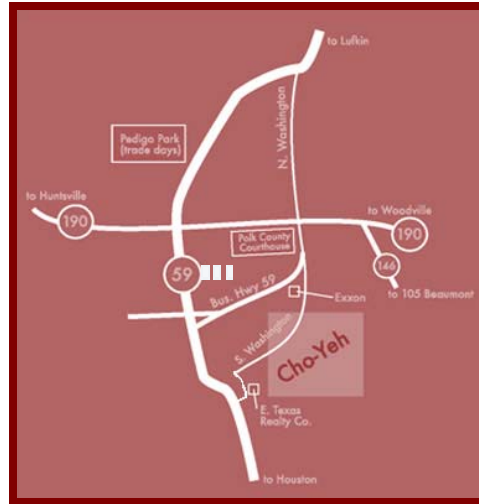

Young Clergy Family Retreat at Camp Cho-Yeh

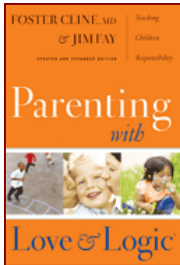
For:

The program for this year will be a roundtable discussion on raising children in the clergy home. Using the book *Parenting with Love & Logic*, we will focus on parent-

ing issues that are prevalent in clergy families. There will be time for sharing blessings and frustrations that come with being a clergy family. **Each family registered by March 15 will receive a copy of the book for study before the retreat.** During the sessions, childcare will be provided on-site, and there will be a break between sessions to provide time for addressing children's needs.
