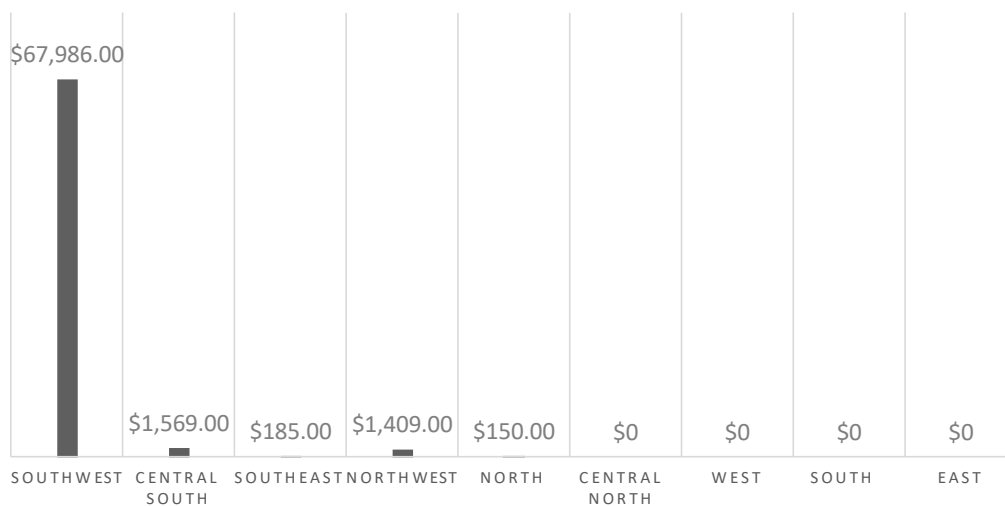


JOIN OUR YEAR-LONG MISSION TO FIGHT HUMAN TRAFFICKING!

INTERNATIONALLY

Along with the Southwest, Central North, and West Districts you are raising funds for **International Justice Mission (IJM)**.

International Justice Mission works internationally within local justice systems (police, prosecutors, judges, and social workers) to rescue victims of human trafficking and restore them to fullness of life. They also work to restrain perpetrators (including corrupt officials within broken justice systems who aid, abet and benefit from human trafficking) and to represent victims in legal proceedings.
