Optional Humana Dental PPO and Vision Plans

The Texas Annual Conference Group Health Benefits Plan will continue to offer optional **Dental PPO** and **Vision** Coverage through **Humana in 2024**.

Following are the eligibility requirements to enroll in optional dental and/or vision coverage:

- 1. Employee must be a participant of the Group Health Benefits Plan of the Texas Annual Conference. Eligible dependents do not have to participate in the medical plan in order to participate in the TAC Humana Dental PPO and/or Vision plans.
- 2. Your salary-paying unit (e.g., your local church) will be drafted for your optional dental/vision coverage along with your medical contributions each month.

There are no increases in the Humana Dental PPO or Humana Vision premiums for 2024:

Humana Dental PPO Plan

The Humana Dental PPO Plan has an extensive list of in-network providers, including primary care and specialty dentists. You're covered regardless of what dentist you use, although you'll pay less for a participating one. You do not have to pre-select a primary care dentist to enroll in the Dental PPO. Once enrolled, you can simply contact a dentist and schedule an appointment.

- There is no annual deductible.
- You're covered up to \$1,500 a year in benefits per participant.
- There is an additional \$1,500 lifetime orthodontia maximum benefit per participant following a 12-month waiting period. The waiting period may be reduced or waived for prior orthodontic coverage.
- There's no charge for preventive care. You pay a percentage (co-insurance) for other services.

Are benefits available from any dentist?	Yes. But the greatest benefits are obtained from using an in-network Humana Dental PPO dentist.	
Is orthodontia covered?	Yes	
Is there any waiting period for benefits?	Only for orthodontia benefits which have a 12-month waiting period. The waiting period may be reduced or waived for prior orthodontic coverage.	
How are benefits paid?	If you use a PPO dentist, then the percentage indicated on the benefit plan summary is paid. If you use an <i>out-of-network</i> , <i>non-PPO dentist</i> , then an allowance will be paid to your dentist based on what is typically paid to a participating dentist. You may be subject to balance billing if the non-PPO dentist charges more than the allowed amount.

To enroll in either the Dental PPO or Vision 130 plans, review the Humana Dental PPO and Vision Plan summaries online, make the appropriate selections on the Group Health Benefits Enrollment Form, and submit your GHB Enrollment Form to the TAC Benefits Office. Your dependent coverages can be different for each plan in which you enroll.

To enroll in the Dental PPO plan, you do not have to select a dentist prior to enrollment, nor do you have to identify a dentist on your ID card.

To find a participating dentist in the Dental PPO Plan:

- Go to <u>www.humana.com/dental</u>
- On the next page, scroll down and make sure you're under the "Dentist" tab.
- Enter your zip code. You can select the number of miles of radius for your search.
- Select the box under "Select a lookup method" to search by a Humana Dental plan. If you have a Humana Dental ID card, you can enter your member ID card and search for a participating dentist that way.
- If you do not know your ID number, under "Coverage type," select the PPO option.
- A "Network" box will appear after you've selected a plan. Choose "PPO/Traditional Preferred" for the **Dental PPO** and click the purple "Select" button.
- In the "Search Category" use the drop-down menu to select "Specialty" and enter the text "General" in the box next to it. Underneath, you will see the text "Dentist General Practice"

appear. Click on it to search for your Primary Care Dentist. You can search for other specialties if desired.

- If you have a particular dentist you are looking for, select "Name" and search for that dentist. Please note, if the dentist's name does not display underneath, the dentist is not a participating dentist in your plan.
- Click the purple "Search" button.
- You can refine your location by adjusting the radius of your search to the left of your search list.
- You can also filter your results by gender, languages spoken, board certification, and practice group affiliation.

To find a participating eye doctors in the Vision Plan:

- 1. Go to www.humana.com/vision.
- 2. Select Humana Vision (Humana Insight Network).
- 3. Enter your zip code.
- 4. A list of eye doctors will populate. They will be sorted by those closest to you. You can do extra filtering by clicking at the top corner "Filter" and select specific filtered results such as language, hours and scheduling, gender, brands, services, etc.
